Send the Holy Spirit to teach and cleanse God's Children (FEAST OF WEEKS); 5. Collect the last of God's living children (FEAST OF TRUMPETS); 6. Transfer the perfection of Jesus to those who have accepted Jesus (DAY OF ATONEMENT); 7. Spend time with Jesus learning to take care of God's Creation the right way, and return after God has cleansed evil from Earth to reign with Jesus in Peace for 1000 years.
