## MDDMF: INFORMATION VALUE CHAIN (IVC): FULFILMENT

When you are determining the FULFILMENT CRITERIA for your PROCEDURE, which is a result of your PROCEDURE, and a Requirement of the PROCESS(s) it is supposed to be fulfilling, consider the fluidity of time, and the various forces at play that are sponsoring the suggested Fulfillment Criteria.

### **DATA QUALITY AND QUALITY DEFINITION:**

When it comes to data, and fulfilment, the quality of the data going into the Procedure, the activities of Fulfilment, the quality of the data going to support the Process, and upwards and onwards, right throughout the Information Value Chain (remember it is a closed loop), is a primary concern of the FULFILMENT part of the Information Value Chain (IVC).

Only the PROCEDURE knows what data it needs, and what PROCEDURE CONTEXT/PROCESS CONTEXT it needs to get the data from, and pass it to.

Which system the data comes from is the wrong question to ask. Rather ask, which Procedure/Process must the data come from, and then, where does that data get put, and is there metadata in the lineage to ensure the Procedure/process context is captured, so that only the correct data arrives at/is transferred from the PROCEDURE.

FULFIMENT is the last stop for Data Quality checking from Source, because the source of data is NOT a system, it is the requirements and context surrounding the PROCEDURE that put the data there, and that is a FULFILMENT matter.

### THE DATA QUALITY ISSUE

There are two types of Data Quality issues, and for this I will use an analogy. Let's say you buy a puppy, and one early morning you walk down the stairs bare foot and you step in the puppy's poop, and it goes squelch between your toes. It is uncomfortable, but at least you know of the problem. The second is where you walk down in your slippers and step on the poop and do not realise it. So, you continue on down to the fridge, get what you need and go back upstairs. When you come downstairs later, everyone else in the house has walked through your trail of poop as you walked, and they have walked it all over the house. It is in your carpet, you can smell it, but you cannot see it.

This second problem is what is experienced by the PROCEDURE and the PROCESS, and in fact the entire top half of the Information Value Chain (IVC), which in-turn spawns efforts and projects (potentially incorrect or misaligned), into changes being made to the bottom half of the Information Value Chain. If Fulfilment does not have ways to test the incoming data before it gets used, then everyone is affected to a greater or lesser degree.

This is an important reason why analysts should pray that God would supernaturally highlight Quality issues in the data, and enable them with the means to fix them at source (the PROCEDURE). However, changes must not be made at source without an orchestration campaign, with CHANGE CONTROL of affected systems, integration, etc., on the data lineages and into reports and other human interfaces, as well as CHANGE MANAGEMENT across all affected people and processes who previously consumed, and may have even made allowances for the previously received poor quality of data.

#### **WORKING SUPERNATURALLY**

Without excluding your sensitivity to Holy Spirit, when defining and reviewing any Fulfilment, understand the influence of other dimensions on the physical realm, and how these are at work.

Pray before your meetings, and pray for the people, process, data, and technology. Pray that these will carry the correct information, and that the correct information will be propagated to the correct users of the information.

You cannot leave data to the systems, or the people, or to AI, there is a hidden dimension that influences, and it will do so on anything that is not spiritually defended. Pray for supernatural moments-of-interruption when you are made aware of things that should not be.

The ideal is to give the FULFILMENT to God, and then to honourably, and dutifully, be a good steward over the fulfilment of the Procedure(s) and ensure the Fulfilment still supports the changing Process(s).

You cannot give a procedure that is not honouring God to Him, and so, to the limits of the authority given you, give what you can to God, and step away from (or out of the Business if necessary), where evil outcomes are being supported, and report all crimes to the relevant authorities.

Remember that Joseph, Prince of Egypt, worked for a Pharoah who did not believe in the Only true and living God, and Daniel, the greatest scientist and ruler of Babylon, worked for one of the most evil tyrants, and yet both these examples (and there are many more) did right before God within their own sphere of influence, and God blessed them in that. So much so, that they were given more and more to rule over, and so many came to know the One True God.

### How is this done in Practice

In the world, what can drive people to do what is wrong in God's eyes is a fear of something. Usually, it is a fear of not being able to eat or provide for themselves or their families, sometimes a threat against a person or an ambition.

This fear is unfounded in a society where all willingly intermingle, care for one another, and share their combined resources, however, this is not how the World and society today is designed. In this world, each person is supposed to fit into their own box, with no one but the world's systems to rely on, and nothing but the world's financial system to transact through.

If you owe no one anything, the strangle-hold of the world-system is somewhat released, but then you have to curb your response to marketing, apply self-control, and find an alternative to the dream you have been sold since your first thoughts.

So, imagine if you did escape this cage of fear (control system), what then?

What would you value more highly if you knew you were going to thrive just fine?

So, when you approach any decision, remember the following table, and choose to Fear the God who loves you more than the fears of AI, people, and Evil spirits.

No one but God knows the Truth of you, sometimes, not even you. All and people, (and even evil spirits) can only collect historic data, trend it, and guess at the future, they can construct models of who you might be, based on what they can glean, but they can never know the real you in your heart, God however does, and He loves you.

At this point in time, God is not intervening in the lives of people because He is giving everyone a chance to make up their minds as to who they really are. Are they His, or are they the world's.

The most terrifying entity is the "God of the Old Testament". There is nothing He cannot do from outside of time, nothing is outside of His control, and He is completely unforgiving. Someone has to pay for sin. Because of His love for us, He sent Jesus Christ to live the perfect life and then be sacrificed as a payment for sin.

But, there is coming a time when God says, "Your time is up", either as an individual, when you personally die, or as the whole planet. At that time, all the opportunities to swap places with Jesus Christ will be gone, and the unforgiving God will be back with judgement and destruction for all who remain.

Until then, having the blood and forgiveness of Jesus Christ, God's Messiah, will save you from the God who has never changed, and who will be bringing an end to everything, except the spirits of people, who will have one of two places to go. If they are His, they will remain with Him in Heaven, if they are not His, they will go to a place where He is not, a place He created, and then vacated Himself from, a place where you see no one and nothing, touch nothing, smell nothing, taste nothing, and hear nothing. Every evil movie you saw will become your reality from which you can never, ever awake out of. Thus, while you are alive, and until Jesus Christ returns, which could happen at any moment, you have to choose now.
