Knowing the Will of God

A Process is a set of Procedures and Capabilities that work together to deliver a set of results that combined with other Processes give "life" to an entity.

End-to-End Business Processes:

Some End-to-End Processes in Business are:
Acquire to dispose;
Case to resolution;
Forecast to plan;
Hire to retire;
Inventory to deliver;
Order to cash;
Plan to produce;
Project to profit;
Record to report;
Service to cash;
Source to pay;
Etc.

The Focus and purpose of Business End-to-End Processes are supposed to be to further and develop the best for mankind, however, they have become about making money, and furthering agendas of the world system. These are the Kingdoms that satan offered Jesus Christ, but Jesus would not worship satan for this. Jesus was after the real prize, saving our souls for eternity.

That said, we live and work within this system, and until we can no longer buy and sell, because we choose Jesus over satan's kingdom of trade, the principle he introduced, for which he was cast out of Heaven (Ezekiel 28:11-18). Note that God's Kingdom does not permit giving back to those who gave to you, i.e. it is anti-trade.

Nevertheless, we are here to make a difference, and will continue to work in some way, shape, or form, supporting what God said He would bring forth, a "giant magnet" or "vacuum cleaner", which would test the hearts of people, and draw those who choose not to accept His sacrifice of Jesus Christ to set them free, to forgive all of everything, and to simply give away without keeping a record of their giving, into it.

God does this so that He can rescue those who truly choose Jesus Christ, the only "Door" created through which people can be reconciled as perfect (Jesus paid for their sin) to God.

Stages in **People** are: Conception; Birth; Infant; Toddler; Child; Adolescent (Teenager); Young Adult; Adult; Parent; Grand-Parent; Great-Grand-Parent; and at some point, in this time-line, comes Transition: Death; Permanent parting; and Transfer of worldly assets and responsibilities.

Some End-to-End Processes in People are

Contributing to Legacy; Distracted to Focused; Ignorant to Responsible; Purchase to Maintain; Receive to Use; Selfish to Mentoring; Work to Reward; Etc.

End-to-End Processes of God:

Conception (and Soul population);

Pre-natal;

Birth;

Experiencing satan's kingdom of Darkness;

Introduction to God's love and way of escape;

Understanding the choice to be made;

Making the choice for walking with Jesus and Holy Spirit;

Death (Transition, "hatching", into eternity in the permanent state of the decision made at the moment of death); and

Eternity.

God's Will (which He does not force on anyone) is for each person to have an eternal life (forever) in Heaven with Him, where there is: promise, hope, goodness, purpose, joy, peace, and eternal value, or

Satan's Will (which He coerces and traps people into choosing, unless they choose God's Will, is that all will join him in eternal nothingness (Hell) the closest analogy available to mankind is that of an eternal fire, but quite frankly, nothingness (with nobody either) is worse than fire.

God's desire and Will is to see us in Heaven, in Peace, as He originally created all.

Genesis 1:26-31

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

So God created man in his *own* image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed, which is upon the face of all the earth, and every tree, in the which is the fruit of a tree yielding seed; to you it shall be for meat. And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to every thing that creepeth upon the earth, wherein there is life, I have given every green herb for meat: and it was so. And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

God's Will is to restore all to what it should be

Genesis 6:13 And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

God's Will is to remind Himself not to destroy the whole World with a flood (But He said He will do so by fire in the Last days)

Genesis 9:16 And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that *is* upon the earth.

God's Will is to reveal Himself to the World. He starts with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, then the Hebrew nation to create and keep the plan of redemption and create a body for Jesus Christ, Thereafter, all who come through Jesus, can return spiritually to God in Peace.

Genesis 17:8 And I will give unto thee, and to thy seed after thee, the land wherein thou art a stranger, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; and I will be their God.

Genesis 46:3 And he said, I am God, the God of thy father: fear not to go down into Egypt; for I will there make of thee a great nation:

Genesis 50:24 And Joseph said unto his brethren, I die: and God will surely visit you, and bring you out of this land unto the land which he sware to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob.

Exodus 3:12 And he said, Certainly I will be with thee; and this *shall be* a token unto thee, that I have sent thee: When thou hast brought forth the people out of Egypt, ye shall serve God upon this mountain.

Exodus 15:26 And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I *am* the LORD that healeth thee.

God's Will is to give us a simple set of Commandments to obey (this is for all Gentile and Jewish believers in Jesus Christ, It is not the seven Noahide Laws that are coming).

The Ten Commandments

Exodus 20:1-21

And God spake all these words, saying,

- 1. I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.
- 2. Thou shalt have no other gods before me.
- 3. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness *of any thing* that *is* in heaven above, or that *is* in the earth beneath, or that *is* in the water under the earth:
- 4. Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate me; And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.
- 5. Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.
- 6. Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.
 - a. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work:
 - b. But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates:
 - c. For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.
- 7. Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.
- 8. Thou shalt not kill.
- 9. Thou shalt not commit adultery.
- 10. Thou shalt not steal.
- 11. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.
- 12. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that *is* thy neighbour's.

And all the people saw the thunderings, and the lightnings, and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking: and when the people saw *it*, they removed, and stood afar off. And they said unto Moses, Speak thou with us, and we will hear: but let not God speak with us, lest we die. And Moses said unto the people, Fear not: for God is come to prove you, and that his fear may be before your faces, that ye sin not. And the people stood afar off, and Moses drew near unto the thick darkness where God *was*.

God's Will is to guide and Direct us

Mark_3:35 For whosoever shall do the will of God, the same is my brother, and my sister, and mother.

Acts_13:36 For David, after he had served his own generation by the will of God,

Romans_8:27 And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

Romans_12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Galatians_1:4 Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father:

Deuteronomy_7:9 Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he *is* God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;

Daniel_9:4 And I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his commandments;

John_14:21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

1 John_5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

God's Will is to provide us with spiritual protection and weapons to drive away spiritual creatures. The Whole Armor of God

Ephesians 6:10-20

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day,

- and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore,
 - o having your loins girt about with truth, and
 - o having on the breastplate of righteousness; And
 - o your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;
 - Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.
 - o And take the helmet of salvation, and
 - o the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:
 - o Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and
 - o watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; And
 - o for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel, For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

God's Will is that you take care of your Believing brothers and sisters in Faith. What you do for them, you do for Jesus Christ

Matthew 25:31-46

When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth *his* sheep from the goats: And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left.

Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: For I was an hungred, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in: Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me.

Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, and fed *thee?* or thirsty, and gave *thee* drink? When saw we thee a stranger, and took *thee* in? or naked, and clothed *thee?* Or when saw we thee sick, or in prison, and came unto thee? And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done *it* unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done *it* unto me.

Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels: For I was an hungred, and ye gave me no meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me no drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me not in: naked, and ye clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and ye visited me not. Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, or athirst, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister unto thee?

Then shall he answer them, saying, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye did it not to one of the least of these [God is pointing here to those on His right, the Sheep, those who believe in Jesus Christ], ye did it not to me. [Did you help Believers, or simply throw your resources at everyone, it is good to help others, but first take care of your Believing Family]

And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.
